1.7	Subd. 3. Lapse: expiration. (a) Any portion of any appropriation not carried forward
1.8	and remaining unexpended and unencumbered at the close of a fiscal year lapses to the fund
1.9	from which it was originally appropriated. Except as provided in section 15.76, Any
1.10	appropriation amounts not carried forward and remaining unexpended and unencumbered
1.11	at the close of a biennium lapse to the fund from which the appropriation was made.
1.12	(b) No provision of an appropriation bill that funds multiple departments and agencies
1.13	may permanently add to or modify the statutory law of Minnesota Statutes. Any provision
