1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 122A.69, is amended to read:

## 1.6 **122A.69 PRACTICE OR STUDENT TEACHERS.**

The Board of Teaching may, by agreements with teacher preparing preparation 1.7 institutions, arrange for classroom experience in the district for practice or student 1.8 teachers who have completed not less than at least two years of an approved teacher 1.9 education program. Such practice and student teachers must be provided with 1 10 appropriate supervision appropriately supervised by a fully qualified teacher under rules 1 11 promulgated adopted by the board. A practice or student teacher must be placed with a 1.12 cooperating licensed teacher who has at least three years of teaching experience and 1.13 falls into the "exemplary" or "effective" evaluation category, or their equivalent, under 1.14 the most recent summative evaluation conducted under section 122A.40, subdivision 1.15 8, paragraph (b), clause (2), or section 122A.41, subdivision 5, paragraph (b), clause 1 16 (2). Practice and student teachers are <del>deemed</del> employees of the school district in which 1.17 they are rendering services for purposes of workers' compensation; liability insurance, if 1 18 provided for other district employees in accordance with under section 123B.23; and legal 1 19 counsel in accordance with the provisions of under section 123B.25. 1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for the 2017-2018 school year and 1.21
