1.3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. NALOXONE DISTRIBUTION EXPANSION.

The commissioner of health shall expand the distribution of naloxone to save lives and increase awareness of the opiate overdose epidemic. The commissioner shall:

- (1) support statewide distribution of naloxone to targeted locations;
- (2) establish an awareness campaign through educational partnerships and social
 media to increase knowledge and understanding of the epidemic and the use of naloxone;
 and
 - (3) connect individuals to treatment and other services through a comprehensive network of evidence-based support services designed to improve the effectiveness and viability of treatment and recovery.
