1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 297H.13, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. Allocation of Allocating revenues. (a) \$33,760,000, or 70 percent, whichever
1.8	is greater, Of the amounts remitted under this chapter, 75 percent in fiscal years 2018 and
1.9	2019, 80 percent in fiscal years 2020 and 2021, and 100 percent thereafter must be credited
1.10	to the environmental fund established in section 16A.531, subdivision 1.
1.11	(b) The remainder in fiscal years 2018 to 2021 must be deposited into the general fund.
