Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 469.43, is amended by adding a

Subd. 6a. Restriction on city funds to support nonprofit economic development

agency. The nonprofit economic development agency shall not require the city to pay

any amounts to the nonprofit economic development agency that are unrelated to public

infrastructure project costs.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective after the governing body of the city

of Rochester and its chief clerical officer timely comply with Minnesota Statutes, section

645.021, subdivisions 2 and 3, and applies retroactively from June 22, 2013.
