1.6	Section 1. [136A.1261] STATE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AWARDS.
1.7	Subdivision 1. <b>Definitions.</b> (a) For the purposes of this section, the terms defined in

1.9	(b) "Federal education award" means an educational award under United States

1.11	(c) "Maximum federal award" means the maximum award that may be disbursed to

2.32	qualifying expenditures. The commissioner must maintain a record of a recipient's
