OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to workforce development; appropriating money for culturally specific  
1.3 emergency medical services training.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TRAINING; APPROPRIATION.**

1.6 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the  
1.7 general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for grants to  
1.8 provide culturally specific, minority-based emergency medical services academies that  
1.9 focus on career development and placement of workers across the state. Of this amount,  
1.10 \$250,000 each year is for a grant to the Minneapolis Fire Department and \$250,000 each  
1.11 year is for a grant to the St. Paul Fire Department.
