Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 299F.01, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.5 to read: 1.6 Subd. 4. Mandatory fire sprinklers prohibited. (a) The State Building Code, the State 1.7 Fire Code, or a political subdivision of the state by code or ordinance, must not require the 1.8 1.9 installation of fire sprinklers, any fire sprinkler system components, or automatic fire-extinguishing equipment or devices in any new or existing single-family detached 1.10 dwelling unit, two-family dwelling unit, townhome, or accessory structure such as a garage, 1.11 covered patio, deck, porch, storage shed, or similar structure. 1.12 (b) This subdivision does not affect or limit a requirement for smoke or fire detectors, 1.13 alarms, or their components. 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
