- (a) \$425,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$425,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of corrections for a grant to Better Futures Minnesota to provide job skills training to individuals who have been released from incarceration for a felony-level offense and are no more than 12 months from the date of release.
- (b) Better Futures Minnesota shall annually report to the commissioner on how the 1.10 money was spent and what results were achieved.
