1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 325E.30, is amended to read:

1.7 **325E.30 TIME OF DAY LIMIT OTHER PROHIBITIONS.**

1.8 (a) A caller shall not use an automatic dialing-announcing device nor make any

1.9 commercial telephone solicitation before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m.

1.10 (b) A caller is prohibited from blocking or using an altered caller ID to make a commercial

1.11 telephone solicitation.
