| .7 | Subd. 14. Annual public reports. (a) A charter school must publish an annual report |
| .8 | approved by the board of directors. The annual report must at least include information |
| .9 | on school enrollment, student attrition, governance and management, staffing, finances, |
| .10 | academic performance, operational performance, innovative practices and implementation, |
| .11 | and future plans. A charter school must distribute the annual report by publication, mail, |
| .12 | or electronic means to the commissioner, authorizer, school employees, and parents and |
| .13 | legal guardians of students enrolled in the charter school and must also post the report on |
| .14 | the charter school's official Web site. The reports are public data under chapter 13. |
| .15 | (b) An authorizer must annually aggregate the reports of all schools that it charters |
| .16 | and are published in accordance with paragraph (a) and submit a portfolio report to the |
| .17 | commissioner and the public. An authorizer's annual portfolio report must include: |
| .18 | (1) the academic and financial performance of all operating charter schools overseen |

| 2.5 | the state's multiple measures rating and focus rating under the waiver from the federal |
| 2.6 | Elementary and Secondary Education Act, with the exception of charter schools that fall |
| 2.7 | under the provisions outlined in paragraph (d), shall also include a strategic plan to elevate |
