BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. ST. LOUIS COUNTY; REGIONAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS
FACILITY.
Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,365,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
to the commissioner of human services for a grant to St. Louis County for a regional
behavioral health crisis facility. This appropriation is in addition to and for the same purposes
as the grant awarded to the county under Minnesota Statutes, section 245G.011.
Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
the state in an amount up to \$1,365,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
