1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 174.03, subdivision 12, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 12. Asset management Trunk highway performance, resiliency, and
1.8	sustainability required. (a) The commissioner must maintain implement performance
1.9	measures and annual targets for the trunk highway system in order to construct resilient
1.10	infrastructure, enhance the project selection for all transportation modes, improve economic
1.11	security, and achieve the state transportation goals established in section 174.01.
1.12	(b) At a minimum, the transportation planning process must include:
1.13	(1) an inventory of transportation assets, including but not limited to bridge, pavement,
1.14	geotechnical, pedestrian, bicycle, and transit asset categories-:
1.15	(2) lead (predictive) and lag (resulting) performance measures and annual performance
1.16	targets for assets in each category identified in collaboration with the public and to be
1.17	achieved by each district of the department;
1.18	(3) gap identification and an explanation of the difference between performance targets
1.19	and current status; and
1.20	(4) life cycle assessment and corridor risk assessment as part of asset management
1.21	programs in each district of the department.
