- 1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for improvements to Gibbs
- 1.3Farm Museum: Pathways to Dakota and Pioneer Life; authorizing the sale and
- 1.4issuance of state bonds.
- 1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6Section 1. RAMSEY COUNTY; GIBBS FARM MUSEUM: PATHWAYS TO
- 1.7DAKOTA AND PIONEER LIFE.
- 1.8Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$7,130,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.9to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Ramsey
- 1.10County to predesign, design, renovate, construct, furnish, and equip site improvements,
- 1.11buildings, and facilities at Gibbs Farm, a museum dedicated to the history of early Minnesota
- 1.12agriculture and the relationship between the Dakota people of Heyata Othunwe and the Jane
- 1.13and Heman Gibbs family. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of
- 1.14management and budget determines that at least \$7,000,000 has been committed from
- 1.15nonstate sources to complete the project.
- 1.16Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.17proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.18the state in an amount up to \$7,130,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.19prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.20Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 1.21EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
