1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **DIRECT ASSISTANCE TO CRIME VICTIM SURVIVORS.**

1.6\$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated from

1.7the general fund to the commissioner of public safety for the Office of Justice Programs to

1.8award grants to victim survivors of crime to support the needs of victim survivors and

1.9mitigate the impacts of crime on those individuals. The eligibility requirements for grant

1.10recipients and mechanism for distribution of funds shall be developed by the director in

1.11consultation with Violence Free Minnesota, the Minnesota Coalition Against Sexual Assault,

1.12Minnesota Alliance on Crime, the Minnesota Indian Women Sexual Assault Coalition, and

1.13Sacred Hoop Coalition.
