- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 13D.01, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **In executive branch, local government.** All meetings, including executive
- 1.8 sessions, must be open to the public
- 1.9 (a) of a state
- 1.10 (1) agency,
- 1.11 (2) board,
- 1.12 (3) commission, or
- 1.13 (4) department,
- 1.14 when required or permitted by law to transact public business in a meeting;
- 1.15 (b) of the governing body of a
- 1.16 (1) school district however organized,
- 1.17 (2) unorganized territory,
- 1.18 (3) county,
- 1.19 (4) statutory or home rule charter city,
- 1.20 (5) town, or

- 2.1 (6) other public body;
- 2.2 (c) of any

2.17 Subd. 4. **Votes to be kept in journal.** (a) The votes of the members of the state agency,

2.18 board, commission, ~~or~~ department, or interagency group; or of the governing body,

2.19 committee, subcommittee, board, department, or commission on an action taken in a meeting

2.20 required by this section to be open to the public must be recorded in a journal kept for that

2.21 purpose.

2.22 (b) The vote of each member must be recorded on each appropriation of money, except

2.23 for payments of judgments, claims, and amounts fixed by statute.

2.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.26 Subdivision 1. **Application.** This section applies to:

- 2.27 (1) a state agency, board, commission, ~~or~~ department, ~~and~~ a statewide public pension
- 2.28 plan defined in section 356A.01, subdivision 24, and an interagency group under section
- 2.29 13D.01, subdivision 1, paragraph (e); and

- 3.1 (2) a committee, subcommittee, board, department, or commission of an entity listed in
- 3.2 clause (1).
- 3.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
