For each legislature, until a new apportionment shall have been made, the senate is  
composed of ~~67~~ a total number of members equivalent to the number of congressional  
districts within this state multiplied by seven and the house of representatives is composed  
of ~~134~~ a total number of members equivalent to the number of congressional districts  
within this state multiplied by 14.

Subdivision 1. **Legislative districts.** The representatives in the senate and house  
of representatives are apportioned throughout the state in ~~67~~ a total number of senate  
districts equivalent to the number of congressional districts within this state multiplied  
by seven and ~~134~~ a total number of house of representatives districts equivalent to the  
number of congressional districts within this state multiplied by 14. Each senate district  
is entitled to elect one senator and each house of representatives district is entitled  
to elect one representative. A senate district may not be divided on the formation of  
a congressional district.

Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

- 2.1           Sections 1 and 2 are effective January 1, 2020, and apply to the legislature beginning  
2.2           with the apportionment provided for the 2022 general election.
