1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 325E.319, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 4. Payment for used wireless communications devices. (a) A wireless
1.8	communications device dealer shall pay for purchases of all used wireless communications
1.9	devices by check mailed to a specific address or by electronic transfer.
1.10	(b) The purchase price may be paid in cash if the wireless communications device dealer
1.11	uses an automated kiosk that:
1.12	(1) uses a live representative to remotely monitor the automated kiosk during all hours
1.13	of operation;
1.14	(2) in addition to the requirements of subdivision 6, captures and stores in a manner
1.15	consistent with subdivision 6 images of (i) the identification required by this section, and

1.17	(3) electronically reports all transactions to law enforcement;
