ROSEMOUNT ARMORY. 1.5 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$10,507,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds 1.6 fund to the adjutant general to design, construct, renovate, furnish, and equip capital 1.7 improvements to the National Guard Readiness Center in Rosemount. 1.8 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.9 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.10 the state in an amount up to \$10,507,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.11 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.12 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.13 Subd. 3. Unspent appropriations.
