BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. CITY OF BLUE EARTH; LOCAL TAX AUTHORIZED. 1.5 Subdivision 1. Sales and use tax authorization. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, 1.6 section 477A.016, or any other law, ordinance, or city charter, and as approved by the voters 1.7 at the general election of November 6, 2018, the city of Blue Earth may impose by ordinance 1.8 1.9 a sales and use tax of one-half of one percent for the purposes specified in subdivision 2. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, section 1 10 297A.99, govern the imposition, administration, collection, and enforcement of the tax 1.11 authorized under this subdivision. 1.12 Subd. 2. Use of sales and use tax revenues. The revenues derived from the tax authorized 1.13 under subdivision 1 must be used by the city of Blue Earth to pay the costs of collecting 1 14 and administering the tax and to finance the capital and administrative costs of constructing 1.15 and funding sewer plant improvements, street reconstruction projects, and recreational 1.16 amenities. The total that may be raised from the tax to pay for these projects is limited to 1.17 \$5,000,000, plus the costs related to the issuance and paying debt service on bonds for these 1.18 projects. 1.19 Subd. 3. Bonding authority. (a) The city of Blue Earth may issue bonds under Minnesota 1.20 Statutes, chapter 475, to finance all or a portion of the costs of the projects authorized in 1.21 subdivision 2. The aggregate principal amount of bonds issued under this subdivision may

not exceed \$5,000,000, plus an amount to be applied to the payment of the costs of issuing
