1.7	paragraphs (b) and (c) have the meanings given.
1.8	(b) "Autism spectrum disorders" means the conditions as determined by criteria
1.9	set forth in the most recent edition of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental
1.10	Disorders of the American Psychiatric Association.
1.11	(c) "Medically necessary care" means health care services appropriate, in terms of
1.12	type, frequency, level, setting, and duration, to the enrollee's condition, and diagnostic
1.13	testing and preventative services. Medically necessary care must be consistent with
1.14	generally accepted practice parameters as determined by physicians and licensed
1.15	psychologists who typically manage patients who have autism spectrum disorders.
