1.5	Section 1. [62A.3096] COVERAGE FOR ECTODERMAL DYSPLASIA.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section "ectodermal dysplasia" means a
1.7	genetic disorder involving the absence or deficiency of tissues and structures derived from
1.8	the embryonic ectoderm.
1.9	Subd. 2. Coverage. A health plan must include coverage for treatment of ectodermal
1.10	dysplasia.
1.11	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2019, and applies to health
1.12	plans offered, issued, or sold on or after that date.
