1.6 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; SCITECHSPERIENCE.**

1.7 <u>\$900,000 in fiscal year 2016 and \$1,100,000 in fiscal year 2017 are appropriated from</u>

- 1.8 the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a
- 1.9 grant to the Minnesota High Tech Association. The Minnesota High Tech Association shall
- 1.10 use the grant to support SciTechsperience, a program that supports science, technology,
- 1.11 engineering, and math (STEM) internship opportunities for college students in their field
- 1.12 of study. The internship opportunities must match college students with paid internships
- 1.13 within STEM disciplines at small, for-profit companies in Minnesota with fewer than 100
- 1.14 employees. At least 200 students must be matched in the first year and at least 250 students
- 1.15 must be matched in the second year. Hiring companies shall receive a dollar-for-dollar
- 1.16 matching stipend for the intern's wages, with a matching stipend cap of \$2,500 per intern.
