1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to public safety; allowing participants in original ignition interlock
 1.3 device program to drive employer-owned vehicles not equipped with ignition
 1.4 interlock devices in certain instances.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **ORIGINAL IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE PROGRAM; USE**
 1.7 **OF EMPLOYER-OWNED VEHICLES.**

1.8 A person participating in the ignition interlock device program under Minnesota
 1.9 Statutes 2009, section 171.305, may drive an employer-owned vehicle not equipped with
 1.10 an interlock device while in the normal course and scope of employment duties with
 1.11 the employer's written consent.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
