1.5	Section 1. Laws 2013, chapter 143, article 11, section 10, is amended to read:
1.6	Sec. 10. 2013 DISTRIBUTION ONLY.
1.7	For the 2013 distribution, a special fund is established to receive 38.7 cents per ton of
1.8	any excess of the balance remaining after distribution of amounts required under Minnesota
1.9	Statutes, section 298.28, subdivision 6. The following amounts are allocated to St. Louis
1.10	County acting as the fiscal agent for the recipients for the following specific purposes:
1.11	(1) 5.1 cents per ton to the city of Hibbing for improvements to the city's water
1.12	supply system;
1.13	(2) 4.3 cents per ton to the city of Mountain Iron for the cost of moving utilities
