BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 136A.101, subdivision 5a, is amended to

Subd. 5a. **Assigned family responsibility.** (a) "Assigned family responsibility"

1.8

means the amount of a family's contribution to a student's cost of attendance, as

determined by a federal need analysis.

(b) For dependent students, the assigned family responsibility is 96 percent of the

1.11

parental contribution. For independent students with dependents other than a spouse, the

1.12

assigned family responsibility is 86 percent of the student contribution. For independent

1.13

students without dependents other than a spouse, the assigned family responsibility is 68

1.14

percent of the student contribution.

(c) For a student registering for less than full time, the assigned family responsibility

1.16

is the amount determined under paragraph (b), prorated by the percent of full time for

1.17

which a student is enrolled.
