4410.9400 IMPLEMENTING PLANS AND REGULATIONS.

- A. A local unit of government shall enact, according to existing authority, only the plans and regulations for a critical area that have the written approval of the board.
- B. Plans or regulations prepared pursuant to these rules shall become effective when enacted by the local unit of government or, following legislative or regional development commission approval of the governor's order of designation, upon such date as the board may provide in its approval of said plans and regulations.
- C. Plans and regulations adopted by the board shall be administered by the local unit of government as part of the local regulations until the local unit of government prepares plans and regulations that are approved by the board, at which time the local unit of government's plans shall supersede the board's plans and regulations.
