

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#### NOTICE: How to Follow State Agency Rulemaking in the State Register

The *State Register* is the official source, and only complete listing, for all state agency rulemaking in its various stages. State agencies are required to publish notice of their rulemaking action in the *State Register*. Published every Monday, the *State Register* makes it easy to follow and participate in the important rulemaking process. Approximately 80 state agencies have the authority to issue rules. Each agency is assigned specific **Minnesota Rule** chapter numbers. Every odd-numbered year the **Minnesota Rules** are published. The current 1999 set is a 13-volume bound collection of all adopted rules in effect at the time. Supplements are published to update this set of rules. Generally speaking, proposed and adopted exempt rules do not appear in this set because of their short-term nature, but are published in the *State Register*.

An agency must first solicit **Comments on Planned Rules** or **Comments on Planned Rule Amendments** from the public on the subject matter of a possible rulemaking proposal under active consideration within the agency (*Minnesota Statutes* §§ 14.101). It does this by publishing a notice in the *State Register* at least 60 days before publication of a notice to adopt or a notice of hearing, or within 60 days of the effective date of any new statutory grant of required rulemaking.

When rules are first drafted, state agencies publish them as **Proposed Rules**, along with a notice of hearing, or a notice of intent to adopt rules without a hearing in the case of noncontroversial rules. This notice asks for comment on the rules as proposed. Proposed emergency rules and withdrawn proposed rules are also published in the *State Register*. After proposed rules have gone through the comment period, and have been rewritten into their final form, they again appear in the *State Register* as **Adopted Rules**. These final adopted rules are not printed in their entirety in the *State Register*, only the changes made since their publication as Proposed Rules. To see the full rule, as adopted and in effect, a person simply needs two issues of the *State Register*, the issue the rule appeared in as proposed, and later as adopted. For a more detailed description of the rulemaking process, see the most current edition of the *Minnesota Guidebook to State Agency Services*.

The *State Register* features partial and cumulative listings of rules in this section on the following schedule: issues #1-13 inclusive; issues #14-25 inclusive; issue #26 cumulative for issues #1-26; issues #27-38 inclusive; issue #39, cumulative for issues #1-39; issues #40-51 inclusive; and issues #1-52 (or 53 in some years), cumulative for issues #1-52 (or 53). An annual subject matter index for rules was separately printed usually in August, but starting with Volume 19 now appears in the final issue of each volume. 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

# **Proposed Rules**

#### **Comments on Planned Rules or Rule Amendments**

An agency must first solicit **Comments on Planned Rules** or **Comments on Planned Rule Amendments** from the public on the subject matter of a possible rulemaking proposal under active consideration within the agency (*Minnesota Statutes* §§ 14.101). It does this by publishing a notice in the *State Register* at least 60 days before publication of a notice to adopt or a notice of hearing, and within 60 days of the effective date of any new statutory grant of required rulemaking.

#### Rules to be Adopted After a Hearing

After receiving comments and deciding to hold a public hearing on the rule, an agency drafts its rule. It then publishes its rules with a notice of hearing. All persons wishing to make a statement must register at the hearing. Anyone who wishes to submit written comments may do so at the hearing, or within five working days of the close of the hearing. Administrative law judges may, during the hearing, extend the period for receiving comments up to 20 calendar days. For five business days after the submission period the agency and interested persons may respond to any new information submitted during the written submission period and the record then is closed. The administrative law judge prepares a report within 30 days, stating findings of fact, conclusions and recommendations. After receiving the report, the agency decides whether to adopt, withdraw or modify the proposed rule based on consideration of the comments made during the rule hearing procedure and the report of the administrative law judge. The agency must wait five days after receiving the report before taking any action.

#### Rules to be Adopted Without a Hearing

Pursuant to *Minnesota Statutes* § 14.22, an agency may propose to adopt, amend, suspend or repeal rules without first holding a public hearing. An agency must first solicit **Comments on Planned Rules or Comments** on **Planned Rule Amendments** from the public. The agency then publishes a notice of intent to adopt rules without a public hearing, together with the proposed rules, in the *State Register*. If, during the 30-day comment period, 25 or more persons submit to the agency a written request for a hearing of the proposed rules, the agency must proceed under the provisions of §§ 14.14-14.20, which state that if an agency decides to hold a public hearing, it must publish a notice of intent in the *State Register*.

DUAL NOTICE: Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules Without a Public Hearing Unless 25 or More Persons Request a Hearing, and Notice of Hearing if 25 or More Requests for Hearing Are Received

Proposed Amendment to Rules Governing Building Official Certification, Minnesota Rules, chapter 1301

**Introduction.** The Department of Administration intends to adopt the proposed amendments to the rules without a public hearing following the procedures set forth in the Administrative Procedure Act, *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 14.22 to 14.28, and rules of the Office of Administrative Hearings, *Minnesota Rules*, parts 1400.2300 to 1400.2310. If, however, 25 or more persons submit a written request for a hearing on the rules by 4:30 p.m. on January 23, 2003, a public hearing will be held in Conference Rooms B and C of the Building Codes and Standards Division Offices, 408 Metro Square Building, 121 E. 7th Place, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101, starting at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, February 4, 2003. To find out whether the rules will be adopted without a hearing or if the hearing will be held, you should contact the agency contact person after January 23, 2003 and before February 4, 2003.

Agency Contact Person. Comments or questions on the rules and written requests for a public hearing on the rules must be submitted to the agency contact person. **Subject of Rules and Statutory Authority.** The proposed amendments to the rules describe the duties, responsibilities, and purpose of the code administration oversight committee. The proposed amendments also provide a graduated schedule of administrative actions and penalties against certified building officials, which was required by new statutory language in *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65. This rule chapter also proposes certification requirements for Certified Building Officials - Limited, Class I Certification, and the Accessibility Specialist, which were proposed for adoption in December 2002. The statutory authority to adopt the rules is *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 16B.59, 16B.61, 16B.64, and 16B.65. A copy of the proposed rules is published in the *State Register* and attached to this notice as mailed. The proposed rules are also available on the Division's **web site** at: www.admin.state.mn.us/buildingcodes. A free copy of the rules is available from the agency contact person listed above.

**Comments.** You have until 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 23, 2003, to submit written comment in support of or in opposition to the proposed rules or any part or subpart of the rules. Your comment must be in writing and received by the agency contact person by the due date. Comment is encouraged. Your comments should identify the portion of the proposed rules addressed, the reason for the comment, and any change proposed. You are encouraged to propose any change desired. Any comments that you would like to make on the legality of the proposed rules must also be made during this comment period.

### Proposed Rules

Request for a Hearing. In addition to submitting comments, you may also request that a hearing be held on the rules. Your request for a public hearing must be in writing and must be received by the agency contact person by 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 23, 2003. Your written request for a public hearing must include your name and address. You must identify the portion of the proposed rules to which you object or state that you oppose the entire set of rules. Any request that does not comply with these requirements is not valid and cannot be counted by the agency when determining whether a public hearing must be held. You are also encouraged to state the reason for the request and any changes you want made to the proposed rules.

**Withdrawal of Requests.** If 25 or more persons submit a valid written request for a hearing, a public hearing will be held unless a sufficient number withdraw their requests in writing. If enough requests for hearing are withdrawn to reduce the number below 25, the agency must give written notice of this to all persons who requested a hearing, explain the actions the agency took to effect the withdrawal, and ask for written comments on this action. If a public hearing is required, the agency will follow the procedures in *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 14.131 to 14.20.

**Alternative Format/Accommodation.** Upon request, this Notice can be made available in an alternative format, such as large print, Braille, or cassette tape. To make such a request or if you need an accommodation to make this hearing accessible, please contact the agency contact person at the address or telephone number listed above.

**Modifications.** The proposed rules may be modified, either as a result of public comment or as a result of the rule hearing process. Modifications must be supported by data and views submitted to the agency or presented at the hearing and the adopted rules may not be substantially different than these proposed rules. If the proposed rules affect you in any way, you are encouraged to participate in the rulemaking process.

**Cancellation of Hearing.** The hearing scheduled for February 4, 2003, will be canceled if the agency does not receive requests from 25 or more persons that a hearing be held on the rules. If you requested a public hearing, the agency will notify you before the scheduled hearing whether or not the hearing will be held. You may also call the agency contact person at (651) 296-4329 after January 23, 2003 to find out whether the hearing will be held.

**Notice of Hearing.** If 25 or more persons submit valid written requests for a public hearing on the rules, a hearing will be held following the procedures in *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 14.131 to 14.20. The hearing will be held on the date and at the time and place listed above. The hearing will continue until all interested persons have been heard. Administrative Law Judge Steve Mihalchick assigned to conduct the hearing. Judge Mihalchick can be reached at the Office of Administrative Hearings, 100 Washington Square, Suite 1700, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55401-2138, **phone:** (612) 349-2544, and **fax:** (612) 349-2665.

**Hearing Procedure.** If a hearing is held, you and all interested or affected persons, including representatives of associations or other interested groups, will have an opportunity to participate. You may present your views either orally at the hearing or in writing at any time before the close of the hearing record. All evidence presented should relate to the proposed rules. You may also submit written material to the Administrative Law Judge to be recorded in the hearing record for five working days after the public hearing ends. This five-day comment period may be extended for a longer period not to exceed 20 calendar days if ordered by the Administrative Law Judge at the hearing. Following the comment period, there is a five-working-day rebuttal period during which the agency and any interested person may respond in writing to any new information submitted. No additional evidence may be submitted during the five-day response period. All comments and responses submitted to the Administrative Law Judge must be received at the Office of Administrative Hearings no later than 4:30 p.m. on the due date. All comments or responses received will be available for review at the Office of Administrative Hearings. This rule hearing procedure is governed by *Minnesota Rules*, parts 1400.2000 to 1400.2240, and *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 14.131 to 14.20. Questions about procedure may be directed to the Administrative Law Judge.

The agency requests that any person submitting written views or data to the Administrative Law Judge prior to the hearing or during the comment or rebuttal period also submit a copy of the written views or data to the agency contact person at the address stated above.

**Statement of Need and Reasonableness.** A statement of need and reasonableness is now available from the agency contact person. This statement contains a summary of the justification for the proposed rules, including a description of who will be affected by the proposed rules and an estimate of the probable cost of the proposed rules. The statement may also be reviewed and copies obtained at the cost of reproduction from the agency.

### Proposed Rules =

**Lobbyist Registration.** *Minnesota Statutes*, chapter 10A, requires each lobbyist to register with the State Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board. **Adoption Procedure if No Hearing.** If no hearing is required, the agency may adopt the rules after the end of the comment period. The rules and supporting documents will then be submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings for review for legality. You may ask to be notified of the date the rules are submitted to the office. If you want to be so notified, or want to receive a copy of the adopted rules, or want to register with the agency to receive notice of future rule proceedings, submit your request to the agency contact person listed above.

**Adoption Procedure After a Hearing.** If a hearing is held, after the close of the hearing record, the Administrative Law Judge will issue a report on the proposed rules. You may ask to be notified of the date when the Administrative Law Judge's report will become available, and can make this request at the hearing or in writing to the Administrative Law Judge. You may also ask to be notified of the date on which the agency adopts the rules and the rules are filed with the Secretary of State, and can make this request at the hearing or in writing to the agency contact person stated above.

Order. I order that the rulemaking hearing be held at the date, time, and location listed above.

# 1301.1201 CODE ADMINISTRATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE; GRADUATED SCHEDULE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS AND PENALTIES.

Subpart 1. Definitions. The definitions in this subpart apply to this part.

- A. "Certified building official" means a person classified as a certified building official in part 1301.0200.
- B. "Level" means a set of actions, as established in the graduated schedule in subpart 5, that are grouped together in a graduated manner to reflect the culpability, frequency, and severity of the violator's actions. A first-level action is considered least severe whereas a third-level action is most severe in nature.
  - C. "Oversight committee" means the committee established under *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5.
- Subp. 2. **Scope.** *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5, provides for the creation and membership of a code administration oversight committee. In accordance with *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5a, this part establishes a graduated schedule of administrative actions against certified building officials for violations of *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 16B.59 to 16B.75, and rules adopted under those sections.
- <u>Subp. 3.</u> Certified building official duties and responsibilities. The duties and responsibilities of a certified building official for code administration are established in chapter 1300, and *Minnesota Statutes*, sections 16B.59 to 16B.75.
- Subp. 4. Oversight committee; purpose and duties. In accordance with *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5, and for purposes of this part, the code administration oversight committee shall evaluate, mediate, and recommend to the commissioner any administrative action, penalty, suspension, or revocation with respect to complaints filed with or information received by the commissioner alleging or indicating the unauthorized performance of official duties or unauthorized use of the title certified building official, or a violation of statute, rule, or order that the commissioner has issued or is empowered to enforce.
- A. The oversight committee shall evaluate written complaints or information received by the commissioner regarding a certified building official by:
  - (1) obtaining evidence related to the allegations;
  - (2) examining the relevant and jurisdictional evidence; and
  - (3) determining if that evidence substantiates the allegations.
- B. If the committee determines that the evidence does not substantiate the allegations, the committee shall recommend to the commissioner that the complaint be dismissed.
- C. If the committee determines that the evidence substantiates the allegations, the committee shall mediate a resolution. In doing so, the committee shall consider the degree of responsibility, and the frequency and severity of the violator's actions.
- D. The oversight committee shall recommend in writing to the commissioner a resolution based on the graduated schedule in subpart 5.
- <u>Subp. 5.</u> **Graduated schedule.** <u>Notwithstanding *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5b, one or more of the actions from one or more levels in this subpart may be imposed upon a certified building official for a failure to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of a certified building official.</u>

#### A. First level:

- (1) The commissioner may issue a letter of reprimand to the certified building official outlining substantiated unacceptable actions and the corrective action that is expected of that building official in the future.
- (2) The certified building official may be required to issue a letter of apology to the complainant and any other affected parties as determined necessary by the committee. The committee shall review the letter for acceptability before it is sent to the complainant and any affected parties.

#### B. Second level:

- (1) The commissioner may require the certified building official to perform unremunerated service as recommended by the committee.
- (2) The commissioner may require the certified building official to attend and successfully complete one or more training courses or programs designed to address any deficient practice identified by the committee.
- (3) The commissioner may limit the scope of work that can be performed by the certified building official for a prescribed period of time as determined by the committee. The limitations may include performing plan review or field inspection services only, performing residential or nonresidential duties only, or performing duties that include only specific inspections or specific components of plan review.
- (4) The commissioner may impose conditions on the certified building official for a prescribed period of time as determined by the committee. The conditions may include mandatory supervision, monitoring, reporting, or minimizing or controlling public contact.

#### C. Third level:

- (1) The commissioner may impose a prescribed term of probation on the certified building official as determined by the committee. The probationary period must include monitoring by a person approved in advance by the committee and may include remedial training and regular follow-up meetings. The monitor shall provide progress reports to the committee on a schedule set by the committee. Upon completion of the probationary period, the monitor shall provide the committee with a final recommendation regarding the building official's fitness to perform duties in an unrestricted capacity or whether further action from the schedule is necessary.
- (2) The commissioner may impose upon a certified building official's certification a permanent condition or limitation as established in subitems (3) and (4) of the second level in the graduated schedule.
  - (3) The commissioner may deny the certification or recertification of an applicant.
- (4) The commissioner may suspend the certification of a certified building official for a prescribed period of time as determined by the committee.
  - (5) The commissioner may revoke the certification of a certified building official.
- (6) The commissioner may impose an administrative penalty not exceeding \$700 for each separate violation upon the certified building official. The amount of the penalty imposed upon the building official may be fixed for each separate violation to match any economic advantage gained as a result of the official's actions.
- Subp. 6. **Notification of investigation.** During the course of any investigation into complaints filed with or information received about a certified building official or an applicant as set forth in *Minnesota Statutes*, section 16B.65, subdivision 5, the person named in the complaint must be notified in writing of information received and that an investigation is being conducted into the matter. As part of the investigation, the committee shall provide the named person an opportunity to meet with the committee and respond to the allegations.
- <u>Subp. 7.</u> **Failure to cooperate.** <u>If a certified building official provides false or incorrect information or otherwise fails to cooperate with an investigation of the committee or the committee's designees, the committee shall recommend additional actions to the commissioner from the schedule in subpart 5.</u>
- Subp. 8. Municipal notification. If the building official is designated in a municipality by its appointing authority, the commissioner shall notify the appointing authority of actions imposed upon the building official.

### Proposed Rules =

- <u>Subp. 9.</u> Additional penalties. <u>In accordance with Minnesota Statutes</u>, section 16B.65, these penalties may be in addition to any criminal or civil penalties imposed for the same violation.
- Subp. 10. Satisfaction of an action. Upon completion by a certified building official of subpart 5, item A, subitem (2); item B, subitem (1), (2), (3), or (4); or item C, subitem (1) or (4), in the graduated schedule that have been imposed by the commissioner, the commissioner shall review the documentation evidencing the completion and if it is acceptable to the commissioner, issue a letter of satisfaction of the actions to the certified building official.
- <u>Subp. 11.</u> **Appeal of commissioner's decision.** Any person who is aggrieved by a final decision of the commissioner is entitled to a review of that decision through a contested case proceeding under *Minnesota Statutes*, chapter 14.
- Subp. 12. Appeal of contested case decision. In accordance with *Minnesota Statutes*, section 14.63, any person aggrieved by a final decision in a contested case is entitled to judicial review of the decision under *Minnesota Statutes*, chapter 14.
- <u>Subp. 13.</u> **Support to oversight committee.** The Department of Administration's Building Codes and Standards Division shall provide staff and administrative support to the committee.

REPEALER. Minnesota Rules, part 1301.1200, is repealed.

# **Exempt Rules**

Exempt rules are excluded from the normal rulemaking procedures (*Minnesota Statutes* § 14.386 and 14.388). They are most often of two kinds. One kind is specifically exempted by the Legislature from rulemaking procedures, but approved for form by the Revisor of Statutes, reviewed for legality by the Office of Administrative Hearings, and then published in the *State Register*. These exempt rules are effective for two years only.

The second kind of exempt rule is one adopted where an agency for good cause finds that the rulemaking provisions of *Minnesota Statutes*, Chapter 14 are unnecessary, impracticable, or contrary to the public interest. This exemption can be used only where the rules:

- (1) address a serious and immediate threat to the public health, safety, or welfare, or
- (2) comply with a court order or a requirement in federal law in a manner that does not allow for compliance with *Minnesota Statutes* 14.14-14.28, or
- (3) incorporate specific changes set forth in applicable statutes when no interpretation of law is required, or
- (4) make changes that do not alter the sense, meaning, or effect of the rules.

These exempt rules are also reviewed for form by the Revisor of Statutes, for legality by the Office of Administrative Hearings and then published in the *State Register*. In addition, the Office of Administrative Hearings must determine whether the agency has provided adequate justification for the use of this exemption. Rules adopted under clauses (1) or (2) above are effective for two years from the date of publication of the rule in the *State Register*. Rules adopted, amended or repealed under clause (3) or (4) are effective upon publication in the *State Register*.

The Legislature may also exempt an agency from the normal rulemaking procedures and establish other procedural and substantive requirements unique to that exemption.

### **Adopted Exempt Permanent Rules Relating to Diagnosis Related Groups Classifications**

Notice of Revision of Diagnosis Related Groups Classifications for Inpatient Hospital Payment, Minnesota Rules, part 9500.1100, subparts 20b to 20g pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 256.969, subdivision 2

This notice provides information about revisions of the diagnostic categories for inpatient hospital services under the Medical Assistance (MA) and General Assistance Medical Care (GAMC) programs.

*Minnesota Statutes*, section 256.969, subdivision 2 and *Minnesota Rules*, 9500.1100, subpart 2 authorize the commissioner of Human Services to reconfigure the diagnostic categories after notice in the *State Register* and a 30-day comment period.

The diagnostic category revisions are based on a review of the 1998/99 base-year claims that will be used to establish the effective January 1, 2003. The change in base-year makes it necessary in some cases to combine previously separate diagnostic categories which had either zero or very low claim counts.

### **Exempt Rules**

Categories have been added to reduce the variances in cost within the diagnostic categories and to create diagnostic categories for high-usage diagnoses and procedures.

The diagnostic category revisions do not alter the aggregate payments to the industry for inpatient hospital services. A report of the relative values for the diagnostic categories will be sent to each hospital with the rate notice by December 31, 2002.

### **Proposed Exempt Permanent Rules Relating to OSHA**

Proposed Revisions to the Occupational Safety and Health Standards and Request for Comments

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Department of Labor and Industry, Occupational Safety and Health Division (Minnesota OSHA) proposes to adopt the following revisions to the Department of Labor and Industry, Occupational Safety and Health Rules, as authorized under *Minnesota Statutes* § 182.655 (2000). This notice proposes the adoption by reference of corrections and amendments to Occupational Safety and Health Standards that have already been proposed and adopted by the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Federal OSHA).

All interested or affected persons have 30 days from the date this notice is published in the *State Register* to submit, in writing, data and views on the proposed amendments to the rule. Comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments are encouraged. Each comment should identify the portion of the proposed amendment addressed, the reason for the comment, and any proposed change.

Any person may file with the Commissioner written objections to the proposed amendments stating the grounds for those objections and may request a public hearing. A public hearing will be held if 25 or more persons submit written requests for a public hearing on the proposed amendments within the 30-day comment period. Requests for hearing must include the name and address of the person submitting the request, define the reasons for the request, and discuss any proposed changes. If a public hearing is required, the Department will proceed according to the provisions of *Minnesota Statutes* § 182.655 and *Minnesota Rules* 5210.0010 to 5210.0100.

The following is a brief summary of the proposed amendments. Persons interested in reviewing the complete *Federal Register* notices referenced below may find them at *www.osha.gov*.

#### (A) "Safety Standards for Signs, Signals, and Barricades; Final Rule."

On September 12, 2002, federal OSHA published its final rule for Signs, Signals, and Barricades, which became effective on the federal level on December 11, 2002. The standard is expected to reduce fatalities and injuries at roadway worksites by requiring retro-reflective and illuminated devices at intermediate and long-term stationary temporary traffic control zones; warning devices for mobile operations at speeds above 20 mph; advance warning signs for certain closed paved shoulders; a transition area containing a merging taper when one lane is closed on a multi-lane road; temporary traffic control devices with traffic barriers than are immediately adjacent to an open lane; and temporary traffic barriers separating opposing traffic on a two-way roadway.

By this notice, Minnesota OSHA proposes to adopt the final rule as published in the *Federal Register* on September 12, 2002.

#### (B) "Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, and Fire Prevention Plans; Final Rule."

On November 7, 2002, federal OSHA published its final rule for Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, and Fire Prevention Plans, which became effective at the federal level on December 7, 2002. The requirements for exit routes have been rewritten in simple, easy-to-understand terms. For example, Means of Egress will now be referred to as Exit Routes. The text has been reorganized and inconsistencies and duplicative requirements have been removed. Employers now have the option of adopting the National Fire Protection Associations' Life Safety Code, instead of the OSHA standard for exit routes. OSHA evaluated the NFPA standard and concluded that it provides comparable safety. The revised standard, which offers more compliance options for employers, does not change the regulatory obligations of the employer or the safety and health protections provided to the employees of the original standard.

By this notice, Minnesota OSHA proposes to adopt the final rule as published in the Federal Register on November 7, 2002.


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
