457.13 LEASING, SELLING, ABANDONING, DISCONTINUING WATER-WORKS OR LIGHTING PLANTS.

Any home rule charter city of the fourth class operating a water-works or lighting plant may by resolution or ordinance of its governing body approved by two-thirds of the electors voting thereon at a general or special election sell, lease, abandon or discontinue the operation of any such plant or any specific part thereof named in the ordinance or resolution.
