

A bill for an act

relating to housing; regulating transactions between certain low-income and moderate-income housing developers and the city of Minneapolis; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 462A.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[462A.35] CITY PROPERTY TRANSFERS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.**

If a nonprofit organization receives funding from the agency for a project to construct low-income or moderate-income housing in the city of Minneapolis and if the city is transferring vacant property to the organization for the project, the city must convey or otherwise transfer the property to the organization for a consideration no greater than the cost to the city for acquisition of the property. The city must also waive all development and other fees related to the project that it would otherwise impose.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day after compliance by the governing body of the city of Minneapolis with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivision 3.
