

A bill for an act
relating to state government finance; providing deficiency funding for certain

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **SUMMARY OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

The sums shown in the columns marked "Appropriations" are appropriated from
the general fund to the agencies and for the purposes specified in this act, to be available
for the fiscal year indicated for each purpose, and are added to appropriations in Laws
2007, chapters 54 and 147. The figure "2009," where used in this act, means that the
appropriation or appropriations listed under it are available for the year ending June 30,
2009.

2.13 Sec. 4. **BALANCE CARRIED FORWARD.**

2.14 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.152, subdivision 2, any positive
2.15 unrestricted general fund balance on June 30, 2009, is carried forward in the general
2.16 fund to fiscal year 2010.

2.17 Sec. 5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2.18 Sections 1 to 4 are effective the day following final enactment.
