

A bill for an act

relating to impaired driving; eliminating the pretrial application of certain civil sanctions for impaired driving, including administrative license revocation, vehicle license plate impoundment, and vehicle forfeiture; restructuring postconviction driver's license revocation periods, including work permits, restricted driver's licenses, and B-cards; authorizing a payable fine for misdemeanor impaired driving offenses; establishing requirements for abstinence and rehabilitation for multiple repeat impaired driving offenders; providing for proposals to replace breath testing devices for alcohol concentration breath tests; amending Minnesota Statutes 2008, sections 84.91; 86B.331; 169.13, subdivision 1, by adding a subdivision; 169.89, subdivision 2; 169A.20, subdivision 2; 169A.44, subdivision 2; 169A.47; 169A.50; 169A.52; 169A.54, subdivisions 1, 10, by adding a subdivision; 169A.55; 169A.60; 169A.63; 169A.75; 171.29, subdivision 1; 171.30; 609.02, subdivision 4a; 609.0331; 609.0332, subdivision 1; 609.101, subdivision 4; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 169A; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2008, sections 169A.276, subdivision 3; 169A.53; 171.165, subdivision 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

ARTICLE 1

REPEALING PRETRIAL SANCTIONS FOR IMPAIRED DRIVING

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 84.91, is amended to read:

84.91 OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES BY PERSONS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

Subdivision 1. **Acts prohibited.** (a) No owner or other person having charge or control of any snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle shall authorize or permit any individual the person knows or has reason to believe is under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance or other substance to operate the snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle anywhere in this state or on the ice of any boundary water of this state.
