

A bill for an act

relating to taxation; individual income and property tax refund; providing
a checkoff for general fund contributions; proposing coding for new law in
Minnesota Statutes, chapter 290.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[290.433] I'M NOT TAXED ENOUGH ALREADY FUND CHECKOFF.**

(a) An individual who files an income tax return or property tax refund claim form
may designate on the original return that \$1 or more shall be added to the tax or deducted
from the refund that would otherwise be payable by or to that individual and paid into the
general fund.

(b) All amounts designated by individuals under paragraph (a) must be deposited in
the state treasury and credited to the general fund.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for taxable years beginning after
December 31, 2009.
