

A bill for an act
relating to capital investment; transferring money appropriated for the Bayport
storm sewer project to the city of Oak Park Heights for a pedestrian tunnel;
amending Laws 2008, chapter 179, section 22, subdivision 8.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 2008, chapter 179, section 22, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. Bayport Storm Sewer Oak Park
Heights Pedestrian Tunnel 150,000
