1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 179A.20, subdivision 3, is amended to

1.6read:

1.7Subd. 3. **Duration.** The duration of the contract is negotiable but shall not exceed

1.8three years. Any contract between a school board and an exclusive representative of

1.9teachers shall be for a term of two years, beginning on July 1 of each odd-numbered year.

1.10A contract between a school board and an exclusive representative of teachers shall contain

1.11the teachers' compensation including fringe benefits for the entire two-year term and shall

1.12not contain a wage reopening clause or any other provision for the renegotiation of the

1.13teachers' compensation. A contract between a school board and an exclusive representative

1.14of teachers must not contain any clause that increases the compensation, including fringe

1.15benefits and step and lane increases, of any teacher after the two-year term of contract.
