Section 1. ASIAN-PACIFIC MINNESOTAN WOMEN PROTECTION AND SUPPORT PROGRAM TASK FORCE.

Subdivision 1. Establishment. The commissioner of human services and the Council on Asian-Pacific Minnesotans shall appoint an advisory task force by June 1, 2014, to research the existing system of support for Asian-Pacific Minnesotan women and their children living in vulnerable and dangerous circumstances, the effectiveness of the system in providing aid to Asian-Pacific Minnesotan women and their children, and any further improvements of the system to ensure that culturally and linguistically accessible resources are available and delivered to Asian-Pacific Minnesotan women and their children.

Subd. 2. **Duties.** The duties of the task force include:
