1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. 2017 S.F. No. 1456, article 8, section 12, if enacted, is amended to read:

1.7 Sec. 12. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 345.42, is amended by adding a subdivision to

1.8 read:

1.9 Subd. 1a. **Required lists.** (a) Beginning January 1, 2018, and annually thereafter, and

1.10 provided that a member has requested it, the commissioner shall provide to each member

1.11 of the legislature a list in electronic form of all persons appearing to be owners of abandoned

1.12 property whose last known address is located in the legislator's respective legislative district.

1.13 (b) Beginning July 1, ~~2017~~ 2018, and every six months thereafter, and provided that a

1.14 county has requested it, the commissioner shall provide to the county a list in electronic

1.15 form of all persons appearing to be owners of abandoned property whose last known address

1.16 is located in the county. A request under this paragraph must be made in writing by a person

1.17 authorized by the county to make the request and is good until canceled.

1.18 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.19 Unless otherwise provided, each section of this act is effective at the time the provision

1.20 being corrected is effective.
