- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to energy; requiring an energy rate payer impact analysis for bills affecting
- 1.3 Minnesota energy costs; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
- 1.4 chapter 3.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[3.9855] ENERGY RATEPAYER IMPACT ANALYSIS.**
- 1.7 A bill that affects the cost of energy in Minnesota must not pass in the house of
- 1.8 representatives or the senate unless an analysis on the bill's impact with respect to the rates
- 1.9 paid by Minnesota energy consumers has been performed and made available to legislators
- 1.10 and the public. The house of representatives and the senate must adopt rules to implement
- 1.11 this section.
- 1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and
- 1.13 applies to bills passed by the house of representatives or the senate after January 1, 2021.
