1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[477A.0176] AID ELIMINATION FOR INADEQUATE POLICE**

1.7 **PROTECTION.**

1.8 Beginning July 1, 2020, aid payments under sections 477A.011 to 477A.03 are reduced

1.9 to zero for any calendar year in which a city of the first class abolishes, eliminates funding

1.10 for, or does not provide adequate police protection of its citizenry.
