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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

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Section 1. **RULEMAKING; BOARD OF PHARMACY.**

The Board of Pharmacy must amend Minnesota Rules, part 6800.3400, to permit and

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promote the inclusion of the following on a prescription label:

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(1) the complete and unabbreviated generic name of the drug; and

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(2) instructions written in plain language explaining the patient-specific indications for

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the drug.

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The Board of Pharmacy must comply with Minnesota Statutes, section 14.389, in adopting

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the amendment to the rule.

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EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
