Subd. 10. **Board of Peace Officers Standards and Training; receipt of**

produces or receives a written statement or complaint that alleges a violation of a statute or

~~appropriate law enforcement agency to investigate the complaint and may order it an~~

appropriate law enforcement agency to conduct an inquiry into the complaint's allegations.

If directed to complete an investigation, the investigating agency must complete the inquiry
