1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to higher education; requiring disclosure of employment opportunities for

1.3 fields of study; modifying institution eligibility for state student aid; proposing

1.4 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 136A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [136A.104] REQUIRED DISCLOSURES.

1.7 (a) An institution eligible for state student aid under section 136A.103 must develop

1.8 information concerning the potential career opportunities in each curriculum or major field

1.9 of study leading to a four-year degree that is offered. The information must include but not

1.10 be limited to the potential job market in this state in the major field or curriculum after

1.11 graduation, the median income or an income range for jobs in the major field or curriculum

1.12 in this state, and whether an advanced degree in the major field or curriculum is required

1.13 to obtain employment in that field.

1.14 (b) The information under paragraph (a) must be posted on the institution's website. A

1.15 link to the information, together with a brief description of the type of information available,

1.16 must be posted on the website of each institution eligible for state student aid under section

1.17 136A.103 that offers four-year degrees. The institution is not required to publish the

1.18 information developed in school catalogs, but school catalogs must include, in a prominent

1.19 location, the website address for the information and a brief description of the type of

1.20 information that is available.
