- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 142B.41, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.7 to read:
- 1.8 Subd. 7a. **Staff distribution.** Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, part 9503.0040, subpart
- 1.9 2, item B, an aide may substitute for a teacher during morning arrival and afternoon departure
- 1.10 times in a licensed child care center if the total arrival and departure time does not exceed
- 1.11 25 percent of the center's daily hours of operation. In order for an aide to be used in this
- 1.12 capacity, an aide must:
- 1.13 (1) be at least 18 years of age;
- 1.14 (2) have worked in the licensed child care center for a minimum of 30 days; and
- 1.15 (3) have completed all preservice and first-90-days training required for licensing.
- 1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2025.
