1.5	Section 1. [462.3655] MINIMUM PARKING MANDATES PROHIBITED.
1.6	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, home rule charter, or ordinance to the
1.7	contrary, a political subdivision shall not impose minimum parking mandates for residential
1.8	commercial, or industrial properties within its jurisdiction.
1.9	(b) For purposes of this section, "minimum parking mandate" means a law, rule, or
1.10	ordinance that specifies a minimum number of off-street motor vehicle parking spaces,
1.11	including within a garage or other enclosed area, except that additional disability parking
1.12	spaces may be required to meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
