Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412, subdivision 10, is amended to 1.5 read: 1.6 Subd. 10. **Employment of minors.** No person under 18 years of age may serve or sell 1.7 intoxicating liquor in a retail intoxicating liquor establishment that has an off-sale intoxicating 1.8 liquor license. Notwithstanding section 181A.115, a person 17 years of age may serve or 1.9 sell intoxicating liquor in a retail establishment that has an on-sale intoxicating liquor license, 1.10 provided that the service or sale is supervised by an employee of the establishment who is 1.11 over 17 years of age. 1.12
