- 1.1A bill for an act
- 1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money to rehabilitate the George
- 1.3Stoppel historic site and for capital improvements to the History Center of Olmsted
- 1.4County.
- 1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; GEORGE STOPPEL HISTORIC SITE.**
- 1.7\$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the Minnesota
- 1.8Historical Society for one or more grants to the Olmsted County Historical Society. Of this
- 1.9amount, \$850,000 is to rehabilitate the historic George Stoppel stone house and barn and
- 1.10to construct an accessible pathway to the farmstead, a property that is listed on the National
- 1.11Register of Historic Places and owned by the Olmsted County Historical Society. \$2,150,000
- 1.12of this amount is to design and construct renovations to the History Center of Olmsted
- 1.13County in Rochester. All work must follow the standards outlined in the U.S. Secretary of
- 1.14the Interior's Treatment of Historic Properties. This appropriation is onetime and is available
- 1.15until the projects are completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.
