BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 145.423, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. Recognition; medical care. An A born alive infant who is born alive as a result of an abortion shall be fully recognized as a human person, and accorded immediate protection under the law. All reasonable measures consistent with good medical practice, including the compilation of appropriate medical records, shall be taken by the responsible medical personnel to eare for the infant who is born alive preserve the life and health of the born alive infant.
