- 1.10 Subdivision 1. **Transactions.** The following retail deliveries are exempt from the fee
- 1.11 imposed by this chapter:
- 1.12 (1) a retail delivery to a purchaser who is exempt from tax under chapter 297A;
- 1.13 (2) a retail delivery on a motor vehicle for which a permit issued by the commissioner
- 1.14 of transportation or a road authority is required under chapter 169 or 221 and the retailer
- 1.15 has maintained books and records through reasonable and verifiable standards that the retail
- 1.16 delivery was on a qualifying vehicle;
- 1.17 (3) a retail delivery of fuel products;
- 1.18 (4) a retail delivery resulting from a retail sale of food and food ingredients or prepared
