1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to commerce; requiring insurers to provide a copy of a current policy to
1.3 the insured; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 72A.20, by adding a
1.4 subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 72A.20, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 42. Availability of current policy. After an original policy has been issued, an
1.9 insurer must deliver a copy of the current policy to the first named insured within 21 days
1.10 of the date a request for the current policy is received. The copy may be delivered in paper
1.11 form, electronically, or via a website link. An insurer is required to provide a current policy
1.12 in response to a request under this subdivision once per policy period.
