- 1.3activities of the office; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter

- 1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6Section 1. **[8.312] ANNUAL REPORT.**
- 1.7By July 15 of each year, the attorney general must submit a report to the chairs and
- 1.8ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over judiciary,
- 1.9civil law, or criminal law. The report must list all legal proceedings in which the
- 1.10constitutionality of a state statute has been challenged. For each case, the report must describe
- 1.11the statute being challenged, the attorney general's efforts to defend the constitutionality of
- 1.12the statute, the status of the case, the staff time ascribed to the case, and the cost to the
- 1.13attorney general for the work on the case over the fiscal year ending on June 30 before the
- 1.14report date.
- 1.15**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
